Resolution 8.

Rule 18. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS: *that the first paragraph after (a-g) be amended from:*

“A Special General Meeting of the Club shall be convened within 42 days either by the Committee or on a written requisition signed by 15 entitled Members being given to the Committee. Such requisition shall be in the form of a resolution and discussion at the meeting shall be confined to that subject only.”

To read:

“A Special General Meeting of the Club shall be convened within 42 days either by the Committee or on a written requisition signed by **30** entitled Members being given to the Committee. Such requisition shall be in the form of a resolution and discussion at the meeting shall be confined to that subject only.”

NOTE: Despite the membership increasing considerably over the years, the number of members required to call a Special General Meeting has not changed for more than 50 years. The increase to 30 entitled Members still equates to less than 5% of the membership being able to request an SGM.
