

# SEATON CAREW GOLF CLUB M&E Preferred Layout

## DESIGN RATIONALE

This plan delivers the best 18 hole course for Seaton Carew, while being affordable for the Club when implemented over time. There is also a fall-back position, if the southern land is ever lost.

The 1st hole is extended to become a par 5, which creates much-needed space for the 18th and brings the 1st teeing ground closer to the practice facilities. It becomes a far stronger opening hole and links naturally into the Dunes hole which is extended.

The other major addition is the new par 3 at the southern end of the course. This would add significantly to the golfing experience and give the course a fourth par 3 of real quality.

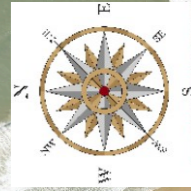
It is accepted that this is on the land where there is the rolling sporting license, but that situation could remain unaltered for the next century (as it has for many decades) so it seems unwise not to use the land fruitfully, while it is in the Club's tenure. With the addition of this hole, Long Trail is dropped out, meaning that players finishing Doctor, their 3rd, will walk a short way forward to play to Pond as an extended par 4.

After playing Mashie and Sand Hills, a second new par 5, is played down to Jimmy Kay before playing the new par 3 as the 8th. Lagoon completes the front nine and is played from a new elevated tee position which materially improves both the tee shot and highlights the quality of the hole itself.

On the back nine, Gare is extended before Chapel Open and Beach. A shortened version of Whins follows as the 13th with a new green so that it plays as a par 4 with Sahara, also played as a par 4 playing to the existing green coming next. The round finishes with Cosy Corner, Dog Leg, Snag and Bill Hector. That provides a layout in excess of 7,000 yards at its longest with a par of 71. Members tees will be set out to provide similar course lengths to the current Micklem course, but with great emphasis being placed to produce courses with the equivalent length and par for men and women.

This plan offers a real improvement to the golf offering for members and visitors alike. In recent years, with green fees at the leading links courses rising to unprecedented levels and with little prospect of that changing, there has been a clear increase in demand for the high-quality but more affordable links golf further down the rankings. Seaton Carew is well placed to benefit from that trend. A stronger and clearer course offering of this nature would lead to increased revenue per round and per visitor, generating significant additional income which, over time, will more than cover the capital cost of the work.
